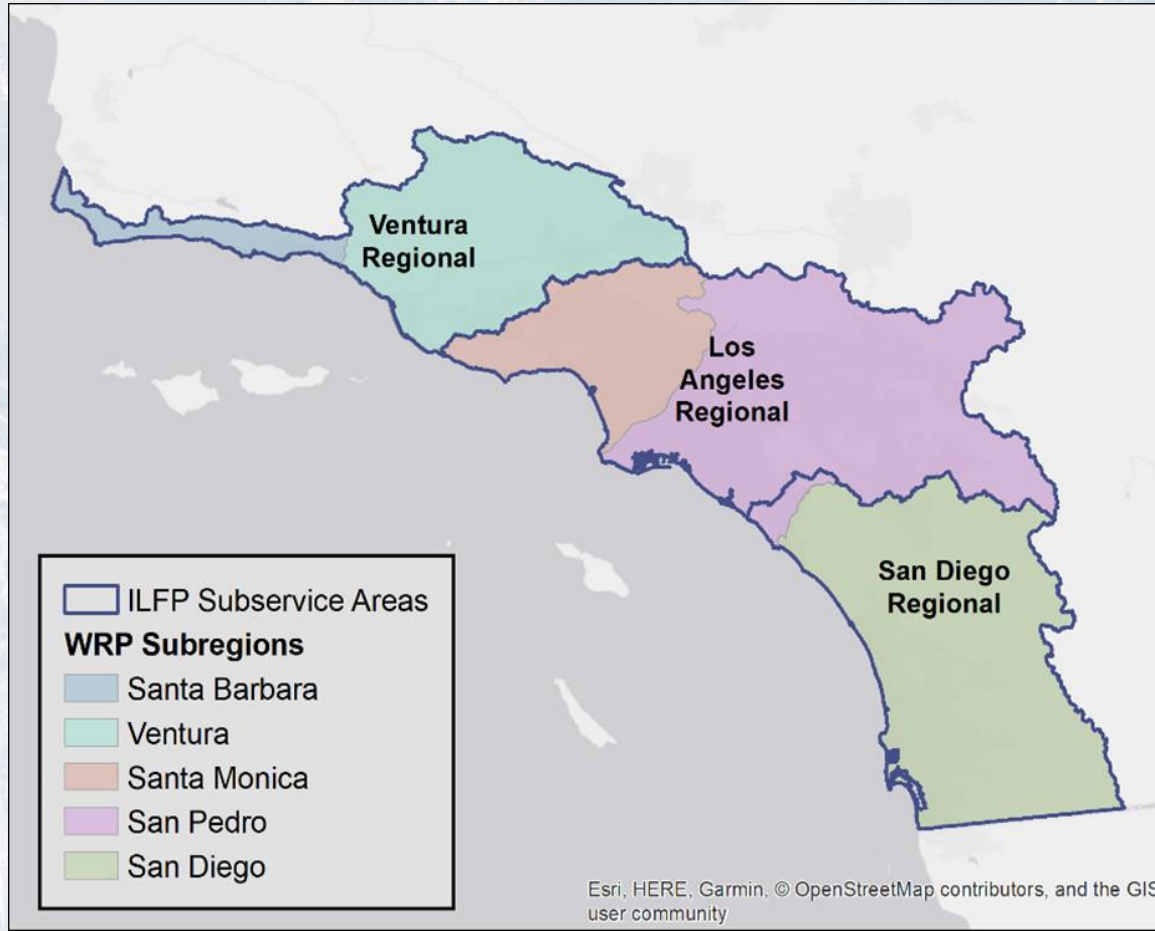
# What is an ILF Program?

- 3) Coordinated watershed approach to mitigation

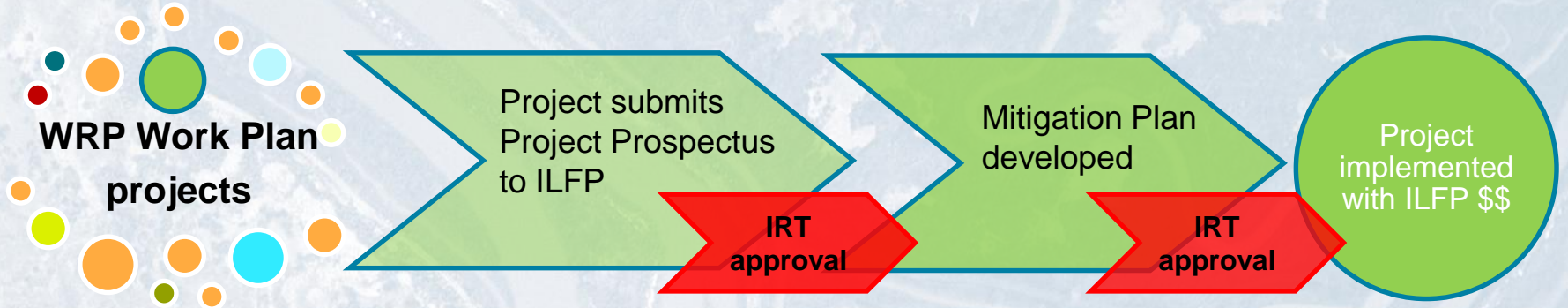
# Why a SCWRP ILF Program?

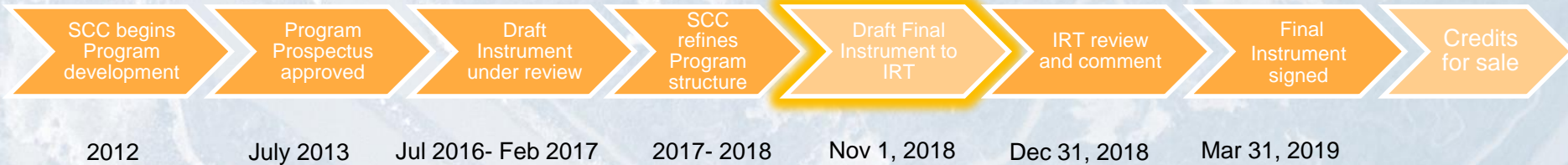

<b>non-tidal wetland &amp; non-tidal stream credits</b>	
< 5	\$506,250
5 – 10	\$438,750
>10	\$371,250
